Though the Academic Library Association (ALA) has started its functioning during 2013, it became an official entity on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2014 as registered according to the Travancore-Cochin, Literary, Scientific and Charitable Societies Registration Act 1955.

During the period 2020-2021 the ALA conducted the following major programmes:

- Annual General Body Meeting of the Academic Library Association: Due to CoVID 19 Pandemic, the Annual General Body meeting of the Academic Library Association 2019-20 was held in KAU Central Library, Thrissur only on 25-06-2020.
- 3. **School Libraries**: As a thrust area of ALA, the meeting urged the state governments to establish libraries in all schools and appoint qualified librarians with provision for library hours.
- 4. UGC Scheme for all College Librarians: As envisaged in the UGC Scheme, the meeting also decided to represent the Govt. of Kerala to implement UGC Scheme for librarians in government arts and science colleges; and medical, Ayurveda, nursing, engineering and poly technique colleges.
- 5. **Recruitment to Universities**: It also decided to represent the State and Central Governments, UGC and recruiting agencies to fill up all vacant posts of library professionals in all colleges and universities in India.
- 6. ALA Best Librarian Awards: -

ALA Instituted Best Librarian Awards as follows:

- (i). ALA Best Librarian Award Life Time Achievement; and
- (ii). ALA Best Young Librarian Award
  - a. The following Senior Library Professions were presented the ALA Best Librarian Awards:
    - i. Sri. C. Abdul Razak, Former University Librarian; For the year 2018
    - ii. Sri. V.C. John, former College Librarian, St. Thomas' College, Thrissur; For the year 2019
  - b. The following Young Library Professions were presented the ALA Best Young Librarian Awards:
    - i. Sri. Binoy Mathew, Librarian, Valapattanam Grama Panchayath; For the year 2018
    - ii. Smt. T.N. Mini, Librarian, Kizhakkencherry Grama Panchayath; For the year 2019

Due to COVID-19, we have not presented Best Librarian Awards during the year 2020.

- 8. Honoured JRF and NET Scored Librarians: JRF and NET scored librarians also have been honoured.
- **9.** Free Coaching for NET in Thrissur: The ALA has conducted Free NET Coaching in Library & Information Science during 2019 (11<sup>th</sup> Batch for July 2019 and 12<sup>th</sup> Batch for December 2019) in collaboration with the KAU, Thrissur. Twenty-two students from different parts of Kerala were attended. Support and guidance for NET was also provided by e-mail and also over telephone for more than 12 students all over the country. Dr. A.T. Francis, University Librarian, KAU was the master trainer who lead the classes supported by other experts like Smt. K.V. Alphonsa, Dr. K.R. Ajithan, Smt. Indu Sunil, Sri. Abdul Razak, Dr. V.S. Swapna, Dr. P.A. Pradeep, etc.
- 10. Representation to Govt. of Kerala: ALA submitted detailed representations to the Govt. of Kerala on: (i). To speed up the direct recruitment of Library/Professional Assistants to universities by KPSC; (ii). To implement the UGC Scheme for librarians in government arts and science colleges; and medical, Ayurveda, nursing, engineering and poly technique colleges; (iii). To sanction the post of librarian in all schools under state government and post qualified librarians.
- 11. **Representation to State Pay Commission**:- The Office Bearers of ALA represented the State Pay Commission and appraised the situation of libraries and librarians in Kerala and the essential reforms to be taken to enhance the quality of education and research.
- 12. Membership Campaign: The ALA Committee and members have done continuous efforts to enroll more library professionals as members of the association. During this period, 116 new professionals enrolled as ALA Life Members. Rs. 72,727/- has been deposited as FD in the State of Bank of India being the total Life Membership Fee till collected.
- Annual General Body Meeting Re-Scheduled: Though we have scheduled the Annual General Body Meeting and seminar during March 2020, due to COVID-19 and Lockdown, we have to re-scheduled the meeting and held on 26<sup>th</sup> June 2020.
